Singapore National Paralympic Council Announces Team for Paris 2024 Paralympic Games

The Singapore National Paralympic Council (SNPC) proudly announces the nation's representation at the upcoming Paris 2024 Paralympic Games slated from 28 August 2024 to 8 September 2024.

A total of 10 dedicated para-athletes have been selected and they will represent Singapore across six sports: Para athletics, Para Archery, Boccia, Para Equestrian, Para Shooting and Para Swimming at the quadrennial event. Among the 10 selected athletes include five-time Paralympic gold medallist, Para Swimmer Yip Pin Xiu, multi-Paralympic Para Equestrian medallist, Rider Laurentia Tan Yen-Yi and current world-ranked first Boccia BC1 female player, Tan Yee Ting Jeralyn.

The Singapore contingent will be led by Chef de Mission Ms. Ng Wee Chew, SNPC Board Member, with the honour of the flag bearer bestowed upon esteemed Para Swimmer Toh Wei Soong. The para athletes will be supported by a dedicated team, including physiotherapists, medical staff, and secretariat members, ensuring they receive comprehensive care and support throughout the competition.

Ms. Ng Wee Chew expressed her confidence in the team, stating, "Our para athletes have trained tirelessly for this moment, and we are excited to see them compete on the world stage. Their dedication and resilience are a testament to the spirit of Singapore, and we know they will do us proud."
