INTRODUCTION

This Guide describes in detail how athletes and teams can qualify for the Dubai 2025 Asian Youth Para Games in each of the 11 sports on the Games programme. It provides to the National Paralympic Committee (NPCs), to National Sport Federations, to sports administrators, coaches and to the athletes themselves the conditions that allow participation in the most important event for youth athletes in the Paralympic Movement of Asia.

- An overview of the Dubai 2025 Asian Youth Para Games Sports Programme,
- The general Asian Paralympic Committee (APC) regulations on eligibility,
- The specific qualification criteria for each sport,

Qualification Methods

This Games is an OPEN ENTRY SYSTEM to help encourage more athletes to attend the competition so that no MQS or ranking point will be necessary for the Dubai 2025 Asian Youth Para Games. Only for team sport may consider the ranking to select the teams according to the quota.

GENERAL APC REGULATIONS ON ELIGIBILITY

In addition to each International Federation's athlete eligibility criteria the APC has established a set of general conditions that apply to all participants in the Asian Youth Para Games. These general regulations are derived from the APC Handbook. They ensure that the fundamental rights and obligations of the APC and its membership are recognized and protected. The General APC Regulations on Eligibility are as follows:

- APC Membership
- Compliance with APC Athletes Nationality Code
- Age Requirement
- NPC Selection Standards
- Compliance with the Classification Rules

APC Membership

Only NPCs in good standing with the APC may enter eligible athletes in the Dubai 2025 Asian Youth Para Games. NPCs are reminded that athletes must ensure their membership with their sport's respective International Federation is in good standing during the participation period and upon close of registration entry to the Asian Youth Para Games.

Compliance with APC Athletes Nationality Code

Any athlete in the Asian Youth Para Games must be a national of the country/territory of the NPC entering him/her and in compliance with the provisions of the Nationality Code as published in the APC Handbook.

Age Requirement

The minimum age to participate in the Games will be 13 years old on 31 December of the year of the Games. The Maximum age will be to participate in the games will be 21 years old on 31 December of the year of the Games. However, NPCs should note that an age limit is established by relevant International Federations through sport-specific athlete eligibility standards.



NPC Selection Standards

The APC recognizes and respects the right of NPCs to establish national selection standards for determining an athlete or team's qualification to compete in the Asian Youth Para Games. All athletes and teams are equally subject to their respective NPC selection standards when applied.

Sport Class Status:

Eligible sport class status to participate in the Games are as follows.

- N = New
- R = Review
- FRD = Fixed Review Date
- CNC = Classification Not Complete or
- C = Confirmed

Athletes with 'New' or 'Review' sport class status must undergo international classification on site. Athletes will need to present themselves for classification at the date and time designated by the sport. NPCs must present all relevant medical paperwork for their athletes with 'New' or 'Review' status to the respective IF, according to their classification rules. For every classification matter the NPC must contact the respective IF.

Viability Criteria

If the IF does not state its Viability Criteria, then it shall adhere to the Viability Criteria of the APC as follows:

- Individual Events
 - There should be a minimum of four (4) athletes from two (2) participating nations;
- Team Events
 - There should be a minimum of four (4) participating nations.

In exceptional cases where an event is already on the final programme and does not fulfil the Viability Criteria during the competition day, the following alternative steps can be taken:

- Technical Delegate's Decision
 - The Technical Delegate reserves the right and authority to move the athletes into another reasonable class, or combine different classes together





Medal

Gold, silver, and bronze medals shall be awarded to the top three winners in each event. However, in exceptional cases where only three or fewer athletes or teams compete in a medal event, the "minusone rule" will apply. This includes events that are combined across sport classes.

For example, if only two athletes or teams compete in an event, only a gold medal will be awarded.

If multiple age categories exist within the same discipline, medals will be awarded within each specific age category based solely on the results of athletes competing in that category. Results will not be combined across age categories.

MINIMUM OF ENTRIES / COMBINATION

To deliver the event, the minimum of participants in the event must be 4 from 2 countries.

In case the minimum is not reached:

- The Individuals in Compound Open, or Recurve Open, or W1 will compete in a same event with no consideration of gender
- The individuals in VI1 and VI23 categories will compete in VI1 category, all of them blindfolded
- There will be no combination for teams, the event will not be delivered

ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for selection by an NPC, athletes must:

- Have a classification status 'New', 'Review' or 'Confirmed'
- Have applied for an international classification until the deadline in accordance with World Archery rules and policy: https://www.worldarchery.sport/sport/disciplines/para-archery/classification
- Each athlete must get a World Archery ID number to enter the process and recognition of classification. The WA member association may use WAREOS system to get it.

- hold an active license for the 2025 season.
- be internationally classified and have been assigned a spot class (other than not eligible (NE))
 in accordance with the World Armwrestling Federation classification rules and regulations.



MAXIMUM ENTRY per country

Two competitors per country per category.

QUALIFICATION SYSTEM

For the Dubai 2025 Asian Youth Para Games, the World Armwrestling Federation (WAF) will qualify maximum two Para athletes per country per category, based on their results in both arms at the most recent major event — either the Asian or World Championships.

In cases where two athletes have equal results, the WAF quadrennial ranking system will be used to determine the qualifier.

However, selection will be based strictly on performance at WAF-sanctioned events as outlined above.

COMPETITION FORMAT

Sport Classes with similar nature of Impairment will be combined in both track and field events.

In track events there will be one round, regardless of the number of competitors of each event. Where there are more athletes than available lanes for a single final, the event shall be run as a "timed final".

Where there are less than 4 entries for an event, Sport Classes may be further combined. Events in which more than one Sport Class compete, the World Para Athletics Performance Indicator will be used to determine placings.

All field events are held as finals only. Where more than one Sports Class compete together, the World Para Athletics Performance Indicator System shall be used to determine placings.

VIABILITY OF EVENTS

World Para Athletics shall review the event viability following the close of the final entry by name. World Para Athletics also reserve the right to either cancel such events, apply the "minus one rule" or run them as non-medal events.

ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for entry, an athlete must:

- hold an active World Para Athletics Licence for the 2025 season;
- be aged between 14 and 19 years old on 31 December 2025 (age categories detailed above);
- Have a sport class status "New" (N), "Review" or "Confirmed" (C).





- Comply with the APC Nationality Rules and Regulations of the respective IF.
- Guide-runners must hold an active World Para Athletics Licence for the 2025 season.

MAXIMUM ENTRY per NPC

• An NPC may enter a maximum of three (3) eligible athletes per Individual medal event.

This Games is an OPEN ENTRY SYSTEM to help encourage more athletes to attend the competition so that no MQS or ranking point will be necessary for the Dubai 2025 Asian Youth Para Games.

MAXIMUM ENTRY per NPC

An NPC can enter a maximum of two (2) athletes per category in individual event and one (1) entry for team/pair event. A pair consist of 2 athletes (1 male and 1 female athlete and a team consist of 3 athletes (at least 1 male, 1 female and at least 1 of them need to be a BC1).

MAXIMUM ENTRY per NPC

An NPC can be allocated no more than one (1) male's team qualification slot and one (1) female's team qualification slot. An NPC can enter a maximum of nine (9) members per team, six (6) athletes and three (3) staff members.

QUALIFICATION SYSTEM

This Games is an OPEN ENTRY SYSTEM to help encourage more athletes to attend the competition so that no MQS or ranking point will be necessary for the Dubai 2025 Asian Youth Para Games. In case, the entry exceeds the athlete quota, the team will be selected based on IBSA Goalball World ranking.

The minimum age is 15 years of age by 31 December of the year of the competition, and the maximum age is no older than 20 years of age by 31 December of the year of the competition.

COMPETITION FORMAT

Para Powerlifting competition will be conducted according to the current World Para Powerlifting Rules and Regulations (with exception of the medal event viability where the Games policy will apply) and, therefore, results will be decided by using any of the following competition formats:

- For an event to be considered viable, it must have entries from at least four athletes representing from two different countries. If this requirement is not fully met, the "minus one" rule may be applied. However, events with only one athlete entered cannot be held as medal events.
- In designated single bodyweight categories for men and women.
- With the Coefficient formula in which the categories are not viable and combined groups are formed.

In the Mixed team events men and women compete together.

- Separate event on last competition day in which athletes complete a maximum of 3 additional lifts (1 lift per athlete per phase; maximum of 3 lifts total if team advances to Final or Third Place Match).
- Results calculated using the Coefficient formula by the sum of the Coefficient points of each athlete.
- Teams consist of three (3) athletes from the same nation, and there must be a minimum of one (1) female athlete. Each of the three (3) athletes that comprise a team may be from different bodyweight categories.

Competition:

The bench press is the sport in which competitors must lower the bar to the chest, must stop it on the chest and then press it upwards to arm's length with locked elbows.

The bar must be loaded progressively for each round on the principle of arising bar whereby each lifter takes their first attempt in the first round, their second attempt in the second round and their third attempt in the third round.

ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible to be entered by an NPC to participate (compete) in Dubai 2025 Asian Youth Para Games must:

- hold a valid WPPO Athlete license for the 2025 season;
- be internationally classified with "Confirmed", "Review" or" New" sport class status with a review date set after Dubai 2025AYPG;
- No Minimal Qualification Standard (MQS) is required.

Note: Athletes who have never been classified and or have a designated sport class status of "R" (Review) will be required to go through International Classification.



MAXIMUM ENTRY per NPC

For individual medal events:

- Each NPC is allowed to enter a maximum of thirty (30) Rookie male and thirty (30) Next Gen male and thirty (30) Rookie female and thirty (30) Next Gen female competitors spread throughout the range of the ten (10) male and ten (10) female bodyweight categories.
- Maximum three (3) Rookie and three (3) Next Gen from the same country per each body weight category is allowed.

For Mixed Team medal event:

- Each NPC is allowed to enter a maximum of three (3) Mixed Teams
- Each NPC is allowed to enter a maximum of nine (9) athletes (Rookie + Next Gen) athletes to the Mixed team events and there must be a minimum of one (1) female athlete per teams.

QUALIFICATION SYSTEM

SYSTEM OF PLAY

<u>Singles Events</u>: The first stage will be played in round-robin groups of even numbered players but there shall not be less than 3 and not more than 5 players in a group: priority will be given to groups of 4 players. Two players advance from each group to the second stage which will be played in a knockout format. If there are 5 or less players, the event will be played in a round-robin group only, without knock-out stage.

<u>Doubles and mixed doubles events:</u> the first stage will be played in a round-robin basis with priority given to groups of 3 with the winner and runner-up in each group advancing to play in the knock-out rounds for the top of tournament. If there are 5 or less pairs, the event will be played in a round-robin format without knock-out stage

General:

The numbers of groups will be decided by the Referee and TD in cooperation with the Organising Committee. If the number of groups in an event is decided not to be a multiple of 2 (e.g. 2, 4 or 8 etc.), winners from the groups with the highest ranked seeded players shall have byes in the first round of the second stage, in ranking order.

All matches will be played to the best of 5 games. Medals will be awarded according to the AsPC rules

VIABILITY OF EVENTS

Individual events will be considered viable if they have a minimum of four (4) eligible athletes from 2 different NPCs. Doubles and mixed doubles events will be considered viable if they have a minimum of four (4) eligible pairs from 2 different NPCs.

Those events that are not viable will be combined according to ITTF regulations.

* In class 11 only athletes already classified can participate

ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY

Any athletes who comply with the AsPC Nationality Rules and the Rules and Regulations of the respective IF of the sports.

MAXIMUM ENTRY per NPC

A NPC can enter a maximum of three (3) players per gender per class for individual events and two (2) pairs per event for doubles and mixed doubles events.



QUALIFICATION SYSTEM

This Games is an OPEN ENTRY SYSTEM to help encourage more athletes to attend the competition so that no ranking point will be necessary for the Dubai 2025 Asian Youth Para Games.
